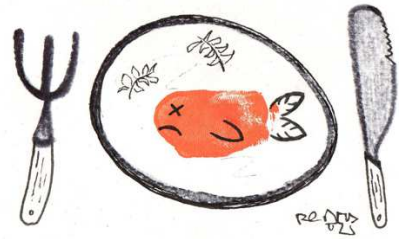


EATING OUT IN STRATTON AND BUDE



The Tree Inn: Fore Street Stratton. EX23 9DA. 01288 352038

A couple of minutes' walk down the hill from Stratton Gardens, the Tree is an excellent value restaurant serving classic English dishes in this historic 13th Century Inn. Booking usually advisable in summer as it is a locals' favourite.

The Weir Bistro: Whalesborough, Bude, EX23 0JD. 01288 362234

A restaurant/bistro overlooking a small lake, just off the A39 three miles south of Bude. Alternates an evening menu with barbeque evenings. Limited opening out of season. Closed Monday & Tuesday evenings.

The Olive Tree: Lower Wharf, Bude, EX23 8LG. 01288 359577

Situated in a pleasant setting overlooking Bude Canal, an informal bistro and restaurant. Closed on Sunday evenings.

Life's a Beach, Summerleaze Beach Car park, Bude, EX23 8HN. 01288 355222.

By day a vibrant beach café and ice cream parlour; at night this becomes a classy Bistro specialising in excellent fish and seafood and with a stunning sea view. Booking advisable as this is very popular with locals. Limited opening out of season. Closed Sunday evenings.

The Bank Tapas Bar, Pethericks Mill, Bude, EX23 8TF. 01288 352070

Friendly purpose-built tapas bar overlooking Bude marshes. Delicious tapas, paellas and seafood. Closed on Sundays and Mondays.

Urchins Bistro, Queen Street, Bude EX23 8AT. 01288 352783

Inexpensive bistro using fresh locally sourced fish and meat served in a friendly atmosphere. Relatively small so fills up easily, but open every night in July and August from 5 pm.

La Bocca Pizza Kitchen, 24 The Strand, Bude, EX23 8QU. 01288 255855

Traditional Italian Napolitan style pizzas and antipastis. Small with limited seating so booking essential. Open every evening.
